# **Exam processing in 5 stages**



ConTest covers all stages of exam/test processing as efficiently as possible.

#### **Stage 1: Preparation**

Define the overall exam/test structure: organization and planning

- Import test participant data
- Creating the test: register answers, versions, scoring calculations, score to grade transformation method, etc.
- Supports partial testing and measurement of competences


## **Stage 2: Distribution**

- Distribution of answer sheets in PDF format
- Both centralized and decentralized distribution
- Print answer sheets to any printer



### Stage 3: Data collection

- Automated data collection through scanning and/or input of raw data (manually, automated import and SOAP)
- Support for both stand-alone scanners and Multi-Functional devices
- Minimum data verification required due to intelligent validations
- Support of OMR, OCR, and ICR for optimal recognition
- Storage of each scanned page in PDF/A format; no discussions about answers






## **Stage 4: Reporting**

- Reports available in PDF, Excel, TIFF, RTF and Web Archive format
